### **Who We Are**

Southern Minnesota TEC is an ecumenical Christian ministry that is not affiliated with a specific Christian denomination. We believe that Jesus Christ died on the cross for our salvation, and that through faith in Jesus Christ, we are saved from our sins.

*Friendship:* From the moment the weekenders arrive at the host church on Friday morning, they are greeted by a combined team of youth and adults who are there to serve the youth who are at TEC for the first time (weekenders). Weekenders will spend their three days with other youth and one adult laughing, singing, being served, and creating new friendships!

### **Inspiration**

Over the course of three days, six of the young people on the team give talks on subjects like:

***Who am I in relationship to God?  
What would Jesus do?***

The talks are personal witnesses of struggles and triumphs youth have faced and how God has worked in and through their lives. Our Spiritual Directors give talks, spurring conversation and culminating with posters or skits presented by the youth. The weekend is a progression of faith, going through the despair of Christ's crucifixion, and ending with the triumph of the resurrection. By Sunday, everyone is rejoicing in the new life that Christ brings and are commissioned to go out to spread God's Word.

*Surprises:* The only secrets of the weekend are special surprises bringing excitement and joy to the weekenders. They are planned by the team and others who strive to show God's love for them. The surprises help demonstrate God's grace in a way each person will always remember.
